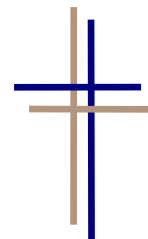

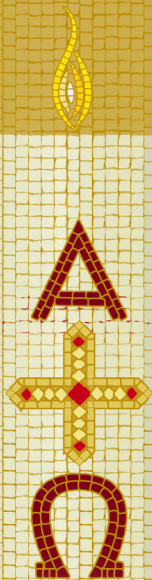

It is a beautiful way to express to God our desire to be united with him when we are unable to complete that union in the reception of Holy Communion. The following prayer can be said while we view mass through online/television formats:

An Act of Spiritual Communion

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

A SPIRITUAL LIFE IN A CONCRETE WORLD

Today’s readings describe the complexities of trying to live a spiritual life while still living in a world that demands concrete action. Acts tell us about disagreements beginning to emerge in the early Christian communities over divisions of labor. Some people are praying and preaching while others are feeding the hungry. In First Peter we are reminded that Jesus is the cornerstone. Jesus was rejected yet is the very foundation for building the community, and yet he is also a stumbling block for those who do not follow the path laid out by his life and works. In John we hear again the contrast of the spiritual and the concrete, of houses with many rooms, of truth and life. Is it surprising that the apostles and we are sometimes confused about how to live the life Jesus intended for us?

FINDING REALITY IN FAITH

The readings today describe a faith community struggling with the realities of preaching, teaching, praying, and spreading the word of God while others are concerned about putting food on the table and a roof over their heads. In Acts decisions are made about a division of labor. Some will preach and others will ensure that the community is fed. In First Peter there is talk of spiritual houses, builders, and cornerstones, of faith and stumbling blocks. In John, Jesus begins to prepare the apostles for his departure. Jesus talks about his Father’s house but the apostles want concrete answers to their questions. They want to see the Father. They don’t know the way. Jesus’ response is both spiritual and concrete. His answer is both faith and works.

FINDING FAITH IN THE REAL WORLD

The tensions within the readings are tensions we feel every day between our faith and the world in which we live. We stumble over stones that litter the way, over lies that hide the truth, even over the reality of death. We want our faith to be solid, so we can test its permanence and reality. But faith is not concrete. Faith is a living thing, a leap into the unknown. Works are concrete. The works of the apostles are what sustained them even as they struggled with their own faith. We must feed the hungry and shelter the homeless even as we speak to ourselves and others of faith beyond brick and mortar. While we live in a world of harsh realities, we must remember there are realities beyond those we see but not beyond our belief. We know that the faith born of love for others and lived out in caring for the sick and sorrowful, the hungry and homeless, the poor and imprisoned is real.

UNA VIDA ESPIRITUAL EN UN MUNDO CONCRETO

Las lecturas de hoy describen las complejidades de tratar de vivir una vida espiritual mientras aún vive en un mundo que exige una acción concreta. Hechos nos hablan de desacuerdos que comienzan a surgir en las primeras comunidades christian sobre las divisiones del trabajo. Algunas personas están orando y predicando, mientras que otras están alimentando a los hambrientos. En Primer Pedro se nos recuerda que Jesús es la piedra angular. Jesús fue rechazado, pero él es el fundamento mismo para la construcción de la comunidad, y sin embargo también él es un obstáculo para aquellos que no siguen el camino trazado por su vida y sus obras. En Juan escuchamos de nuevo el contraste de lo espiritual y el hormigón, de casas con muchas habitaciones, de verdad y vida. ¿Es sorprendente que los apóstoles y nosotros a veces estemos confundidos acerca de cómo vivir la vida que Jesús pretendía para nosotros?

ENCONTRANDO LA REALIDAD CON FE

Las lecturas de hoy describen una comunidad de fe luchando con las realidades de la predi-cación, la enseñanza, la oración y el anuncio de la palabra de Dios mientras que otros están preocupados con que poner en la mesa y un techo para ellos. En los Hechos, las decisiones se hacen acerca de la división del trabajo. Algunos predicaran y otros se aseguran que la comunidad tenga que comer. En la primera carta de Pedro hay un sermón de casas espirituales, constructores y piedras angulares, de fe y de tropiezos. En Juan, Jesús comienza a preparar a los apóstoles para que estén listos para su despedida. Jesús habla de la casa de su Padre, pero los apóstoles quieren respuestas concretas para sus preguntas. Ellos quieren ver al Padre. Ellos no saben el camino. La respuesta de Jesús es tanto espiritual como de forma específica. Su respuesta incluye ambas, fe y obras.

ENCONTRANDO FE EN EL MUNDO REAL

Las tensiones dentro de las lecturas son tensiones que sentimos cada día entre la fe y el mundo en que vivimos. Tropezamos con piedras que hay en el camino, con mentiras que esconden la verdad, aun con la realidad de la muerte. Queremos que nuestra fe sea sólida, para que podamos probar su permanencia y realidad. Pero la fe no es concreta. La fe es algo vivo, un salto hacia lo desconocido. Las obras son algo concreto. Las obras de los apóstoles son lo que los sostiene a ellos, aunque ellos luchen con su propia fe. Debemos dar de comer a los hambrientos y hospedar a los sin techo en momentos que lo decimos a nosotros y lo decimos a otros. Mientras vivimos en un mundo de realidades difíciles, debemos recordar que hay realidades más allá de aquellas que vemos, pero están más allá de nuestra creencia. Sabemos que la fe nacida del amor por otros y vivida en el cuidado de los enfermos y afligidos, los hambrientos y los desamparados, los pobres y los encarcelados es una realidad.

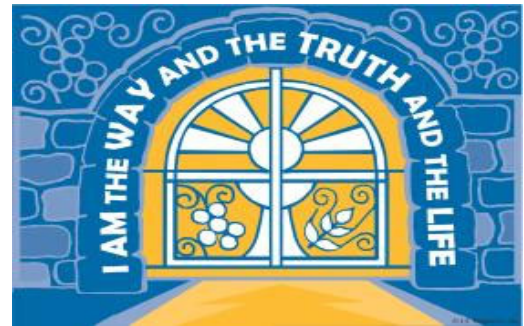

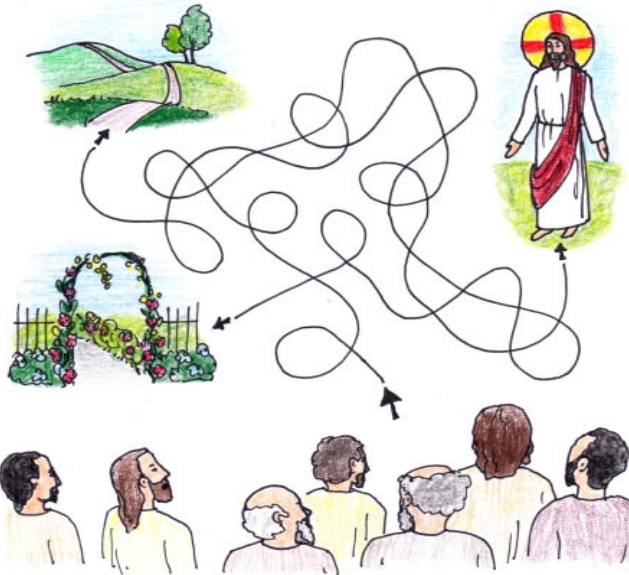

AFTER SEVERAL MONTHS OF SUFFERING, BLESSED JANE DIED AT THE AGE OF THIRTY-NINE.

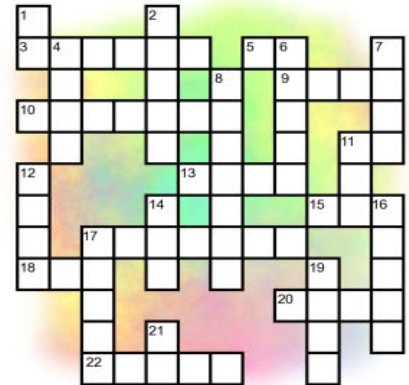
