

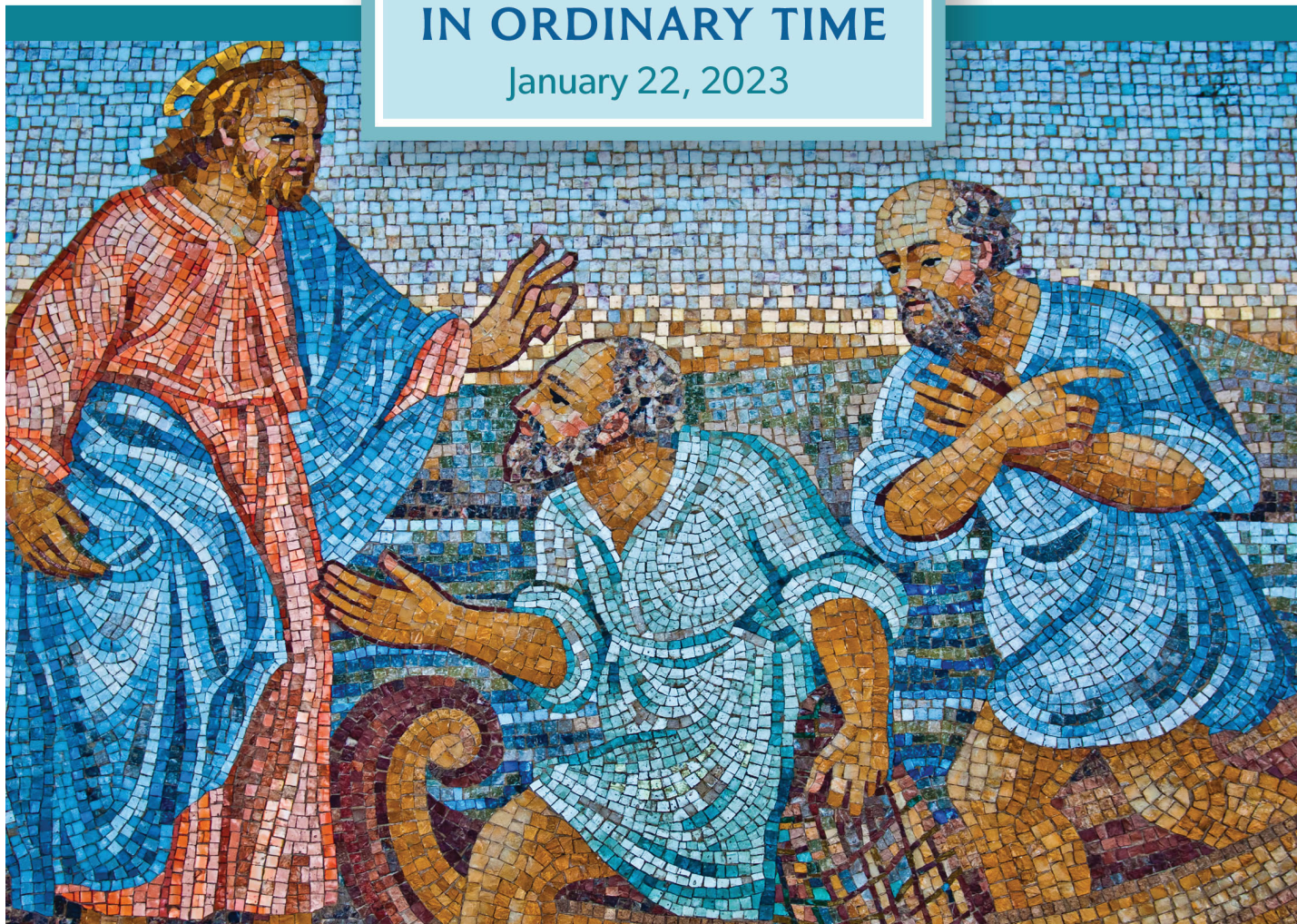

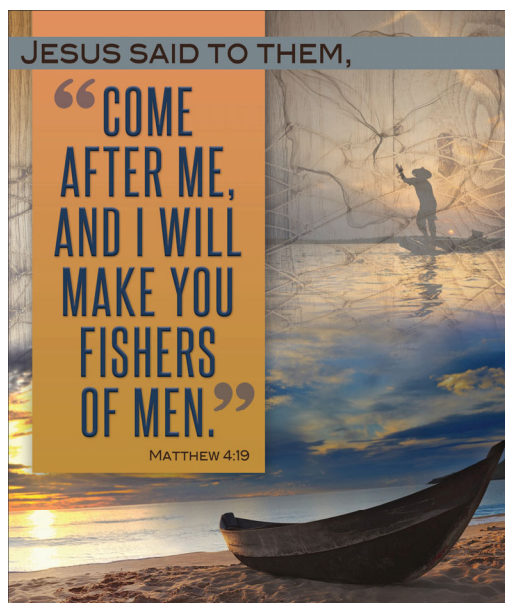

Yearning for Our God

"Like the deer that yearns for running streams, so my soul is yearning for you, my God".

As I sit in contemplation, and read these words from Psalm 42, I ask a question of myself, I ask the question for the entire world. Do I, do we, yearn for Christ like we do our morning cup of coffee? Do I, do we, yearn for Christ like we do for a cool drink of water after a good run? Do I, do we, yearn for Christ like we do a warm meal after an exhausting day at work? At Christmas do I, do we, yearn to see our families and eat together, to get presents, or do I yearn to celebrate the gift of Christ on earth?

The baby brought by God the Father, through the Holy Spirit, to Mary, our mother in heaven. The baby God and man who came down from heaven to share his wisdom, his gift of eternal life with us. The greatest gift of all. These questions are not easy to answer or to think about. It is easy to get lost in a world so eager to take us away from our yearning for God. Or do I, do we, take ourselves away from this path? Yes, there is the stench of sin in this world. Sin we must conquer as followers of Christ.

When do we enter and see the God of our Life? I pour out my soul: do I, do we, yearn for the holy mountain of our Lord? With gladness and thanksgiving do I, do we, go sit in Adoration and talk with and seek the Lord? Deep calls to deep in hope and in faith in His realities. I will praise Him still our Savior and our God. Here I am Lord, it is I Lord. I have heard you calling. Do I, do we, hear His call?

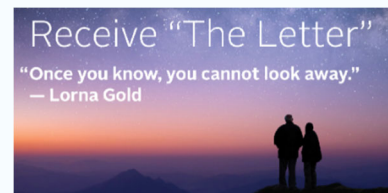


Request Mass Intentions

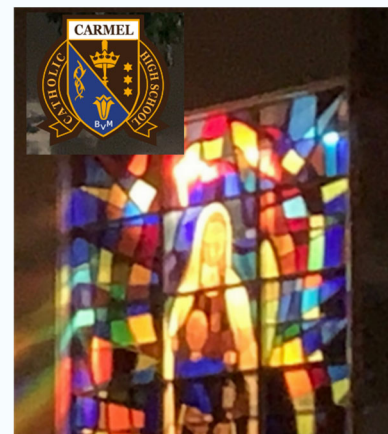

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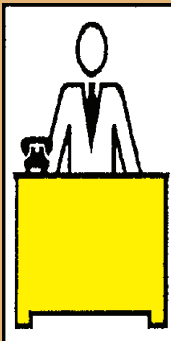
