Real Presence in the Eucharist – A rewarding encounter with our Lord.

The Real Presence of Jesus awaits us to participate and respond. Being the center of our Catholic worship, the invitation to open ourselves to the graces that flow from the Eucharist is real and present. Visiting our Lord even in silence and unseen Jesus comes with infinite power and love. Jesus comes to us with His love and mercy. He comes with His desire to forgive us and heal us. He shares the love that God has for him with all of us. In the words of John we read, "As the Father has loved me, so I have loved you." (Jn 15:9)

Our Lord invites us with all that we have in life. We come to him in adoration to share a holy space and we ask him to nourish, heal, inspire and help us carry our burdens. We ask him to give us the grace we need to do good, to serve our family, our friends, our jobs, and our community of faith with love. It is also an opportunity to ask him for individual favors such as pleading with him to accept and resolve our hearts and our minds to all the challenges and changes that we face in the world each day. Life with unknowns call for silence and meditation. Our life calls for discernment in prayer especially on situations, circumstances and events we do not expect in our world.

A rewarding time with the blessed sacrament brings a deeper satisfaction and resolve to adopt to new steps towards a right direction and moving forward in faith. The scriptures remind us that God cares for his own as vividly as he takes care of the birds of the air, flowers in the fields (Mathew 6:26-30) and God knows the number of hair on our head (Luke 12:7). As such he will always be with us. The Lord also invites us to bring our concerns to him. (Matthew 11:28). As such the Lord knows that we are at times filled with loneliness, or hurts and are at times faced with disappointments. Our Lord surely knows how we are trying to bring His love to others. He understands that it is not easy to walk in his light when we are tired, afraid, or angry. Yet still in his compassion and care, He invites you and me to freely respond and engage with him; "If anyone thirsts, let him come to me." (Jn 7:37.)

Lord in silence with adoration and in prayer we come to you and ask you to open our hearts to your presence and the ever-present reality of your love. Your love is whole and so complete that it is sometimes hard for us to grasp. We come to you our Lord and our Savior seeking your graces, seeking your comfort, trusting in your redeeming love and power. We open our hearts as we thirst for you. We stand at your door and knock. Open for us Lord, for as faithful disciples, we thirst for you.

You are invited to sit with our Lord in Holy Adoration on Tuesday from 4 to 6 pm and Thursday from 7 to 9 pm each week.

Presencia real en la Eucaristía – Un encuentro gratificante con nuestro Señor.

La Presencia Real de Jesús nos espera para participar y responder. Siendo el centro de nuestro culto católico, la invitación a abrirnos a las gracias que brotan de la Eucaristía es real y presente. Visitar a nuestro Señor incluso en silencio y Jesús invisible viene con infinito poder y amor. Jesús viene a nosotros con su amor y misericordia. Él viene con Su deseo de perdonarnos y sanarnos. Él comparte el amor que Dios tiene por él con todos nosotros. En las palabras de Juan leemos: "Como el Padre me amó, así yo os he amado a vosotros". (Jn 15,9)

Nuestro Señor nos invita con todo lo que tenemos en la vida. Venimos a él en adoración para compartir un espacio sagrado y le pedimos que alimente, sane, inspire y nos ayude a llevar nuestras cargas. Le pedimos que nos dé la gracia que necesitamos para hacer el bien, para servir a nuestra familia, nuestros amigos, nuestros trabajos y nuestra comunidad de fe con amor. También es una oportunidad para pedirle favores individuales, como suplicarle que acepte y resuelva nuestros corazones y nuestras mentes a todos los desafíos y cambios que enfrentamos en el mundo cada día. La vida con incógnitas requiere silencio y meditación. Nuestra vida exige discernimiento en la oración, especialmente sobre situaciones, circunstancias y eventos que no esperamos en nuestro mundo.

Un tiempo gratificante con el Santísimo Sacramento trae una satisfacción más profunda y la determinación de adoptar nuevos pasos hacia una dirección correcta y avanzar en la fe. Las Escrituras nos recuerdan que Dios cuida de los suyos tan vívidamente como cuida de las aves del cielo, las flores en los campos (Mateo 6: 26-30) y Dios sabe el número de cabellos en nuestra cabeza (Lucas 12: 7). Como tal, siempre estará con nosotros. El Señor también nos invita a llevarle nuestras preocupaciones. (Mateo 11:28). Como tal, el Señor sabe que a veces estamos llenos de soledad, o de heridas, y a veces nos enfrentamos a decepciones. Nuestro Señor ciertamente sabe cómo estamos tratando de llevar Su amor a los demás. Él entiende que no es fácil caminar en su luz cuando estamos cansados, asustados o enojados. Sin embargo, aún en su compasión y cuidado, Él nos invita a ti y a mí a responder libremente y comprometernos con él; "Si alguno tiene sed, que venga a mí". (Jn 7:37.)

Señor, en silencio con adoración y en oración, venimos a ti y te pedimos que abras nuestros corazones a tu presencia y a la realidad siempre presente de tu amor. Tu amor es completo y tan completo que a veces es difícil para nosotros comprenderlo. Venimos a ti nuestro Señor y Salvador buscando tus gracias, buscando tu consuelo, confiando en tu amor y poder redentor. Abrimos nuestros corazones mientras tenemos sed de ti. Nos paramos en su puerta y llamamos. Ábrenos Señor, porque como discípulos fieles, tenemos sed de ti.

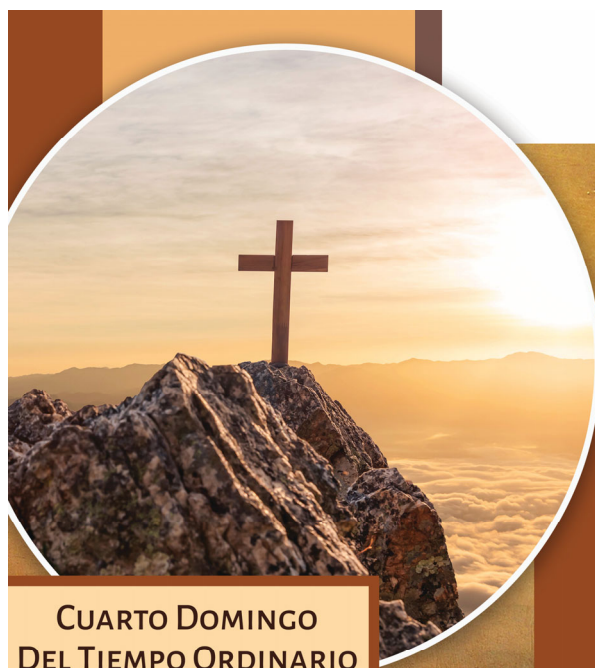
