“ASK AND YOU SHALL RECEIVE, SEEK AND YOU WILL FIND, KNOCK AND IT WILL BE OPENED.” Matthew 7:7

ASK, SEEK, AND KNOCK are the key words in this quote. What a blessing and grace we have been given by God to hear the words of Jesus Christ. A great gift and historic is God's choice to come to dwell among us. The words of Christ in this chapter of Mathew are divine world so full of love, healing, and reproof so that we know the straight way to heaven's door. These words are invitational; ask and you will receive, seek and you will find, knock and the door will be open for you.

The world is a wonderful place that God intended to have us enjoy and minister to. It is also a fact that the world today is full of wrong messages, ways by which people are seeking wrong solutions for their happiness and the hardest door to notice is the door we are invited to knock on through prayer is not being knocked. Obviously, the vastness of the world is limitless and may present a challenge through its too much business to ask, seek and knock. The key question for us is, how can we as Catholics change this trend of things? Can we be part of the solution? Would a solution be that calls on us to love our neighbors, be patient, lift our brothers without judgements, pray for our loved ones that are not asking, seeking or knocking on the doors of prayer and seeking the words of our Lord? Deeper experience with God for ourselves will pave way for helping others see the depth of God's love for us as well. To be helpful is rewarding. To be helpful demands that we ourselves are equipped. We need spiritual strength and energy to continue to help each other in a world of constant change, constant forms of positive messaging that say, do not be afraid to ask, do not be afraid to seek, and do not knock, for the Lord is waiting on you. A big temptation could be, sorry, I have "no time" or "I am too busy". Even in the busy world the Lord is open for us and waiting to see us come before him.

What if a good place to start asking, seeking and knocking is to go to Adoration? Just stop by and say a prayer (ask). The Lord will help you answer your questions (receive). Visit (seek) the Lord in Holy Adoration. Adore Him in His Eucharistic presence (find). Have an in-person chat with him. Come into your church and (knock), tell Him what is in your heart. Our Lord has promised to open up His love, his heart, and His arms for you (the door will be open).

COME LET US ADORE HIM...Come to Holy Adoration, away from the crowds that seek answers outside of the Word of God. The church is open for adoration Tuesdays 4-6PM and Thursdays 7-9PM.

“PEDIR Y RECIBIRÉIS, BUSCARÉIS Y HALLARÉIS, LLAMAD Y SE ABRIRÁ” Mateo 7:7

PREGUNTAR, BUSCAR Y LLAMAR son las palabras clave en esta cita. ¡Qué bendición y gracia nos ha dado Dios para escuchar las palabras de Jesucristo! Un gran regalo e histórico es la elección de Dios de venir a morar entre nosotros. Las palabras de Cristo en este capítulo de Mateo son un mundo divino tan lleno de amor, sanidad y reprensión para que conozcamos el camino recto a la puerta del cielo. Estas palabras son de invitación; Pide y recibirás, buscarás y encontrarás, llamarás y la puerta estará abierta para ti.

El mundo es un lugar maravilloso que Dios quiso que disfrutáramos y ministráramos. También es un hecho que el mundo de hoy está lleno de mensajes equivocados, formas en que las personas buscan soluciones equivocadas para su felicidad y la puerta más difícil de notar es que la puerta que estamos invitados a llamar a través de la oración no está siendo golpeada. Obviamente, la inmensidad del mundo es ilimitada y puede presentar un desafío a través de su demasiado negocio para preguntar, buscar y llamar. La pregunta clave para nosotros es, ¿cómo podemos nosotros, como católicos, cambiar esta tendencia de las cosas? ¿Podemos ser parte de la solución?

¿Sería una solución que nos llame a amar a nuestro prójimo, ser pacientes, elevar a nuestros hermanos sin juicios, orar por nuestros seres queridos que no están pidiendo, buscando o llamando a las puertas de la oración y buscando las palabras de nuestro Señor? Una experiencia más profunda con Dios para nosotros mismos allanará el camino para ayudar a otros a ver la profundidad del amor de Dios por nosotros también. Ser útil es gratificante. Para ser útiles exige que nosotros mismos estemos equipados. Necesitamos fuerza espiritual y energía para continuar ayudándonos unos a otros en un mundo de cambio constante, formas constantes de mensajes positivos que dicen, no tengan miedo de pedir, no tengan miedo de buscar y no llamen, porque el Señor los está esperando. Una gran tentación podría ser, lo siento, no tengo "tiempo" o "estoy demasiado ocupado". Incluso en el mundo ocupado, el Señor está abierto para nosotros y esperando vernos venir ante él.

¿Qué pasa si un buen lugar para comenzar a preguntar, buscar y llamar es ir a la Adoración? Simplemente pase y diga una oración (pregunte). El Señor te ayudará a contestar tus preguntas (recibir). Visita (busca) al Señor en Santa Adoración. Adorarlo en su presencia eucarística (encontrar). Tenga una charla en persona con él. Entra en tu iglesia y (llama), dile lo que hay en tu corazón. Nuestro Señor ha prometido abrir Su amor, Su corazón y Sus brazos para ti (la puerta estará abierta).
