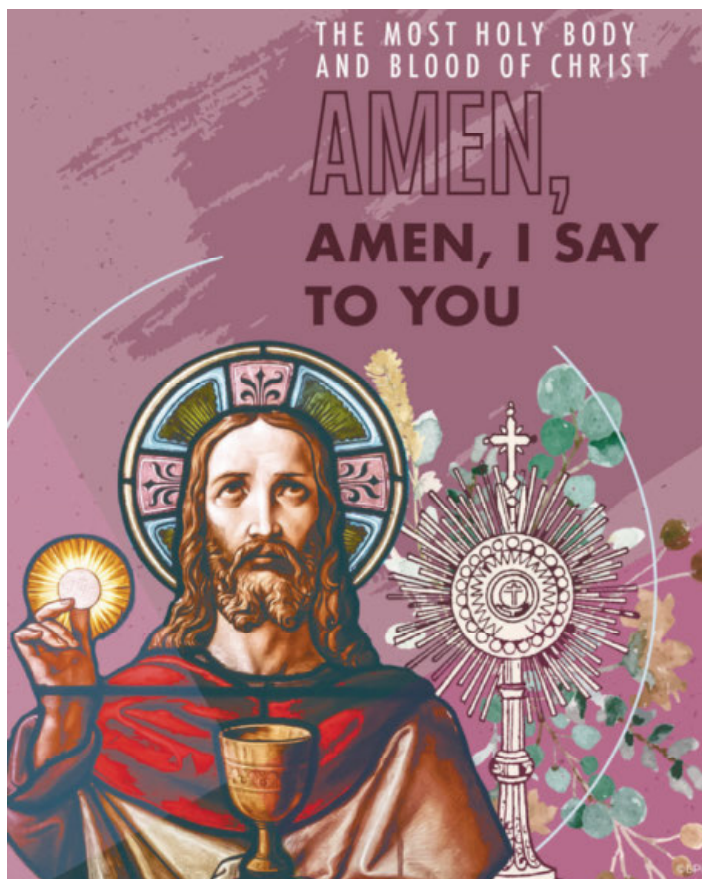

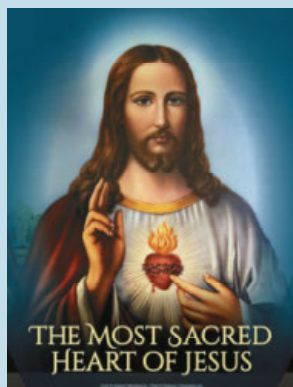

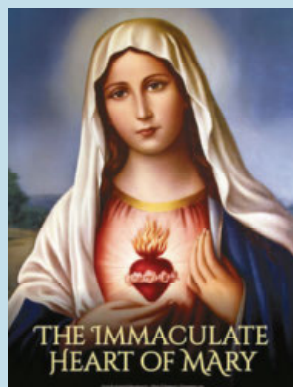
What is the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus?

This is a moveable feast that honors the Sacred Heart. In 1675, Jesus told St. Margaret Mary that He wanted the Feast of the Sacred Heart to be celebrated on the Friday

after the Corpus Christi octave. In 1856, the Feast of the Sacred Heart became a universal feast.

St. John Paul II, a great devotee of the Sacred Heart, said, "This feast reminds us of the mystery of the love of God for the people of all times."

In 2023, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on Friday, June 16.



What does the Immaculate Heart of Mary mean?

The Immaculate Heart of Mary signifies the great purity and love of the heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary for God. This purity is manifested in her "Yes" to the Father at the

Incarnation; her love for, and cooperation with, the Incarnate Son in His redemptive mission; and her docility to the Holy Spirit, enabling her to remain free of the stain of personal sin. Mary's Immaculate Heart points us to her profound interior life, where she experienced both joys and sorrows, yet remained faithful, as we, too, are called to do.

In 2023, we celebrate the Memorial of the Immaculate Heart of Mary on Saturday, June 17.

As well, Father's Day also gives us an opportunity to thank and support our priests who minister in the Archdiocese of Chicago. These 430 active and 257 retired priests have chosen to dedicate their lives to serving you and your family through pastoral care, celebration of the sacraments, and leadership of our communities of faith.

With this letter I ask you to join me in supporting the health and well-being of our priests by making a generous gift to the Priests' Health and Retirement/PRMAA collection for the benefit of their healthcare and retirement needs. Your sacrifice on their behalf not only contributes to their health and well-being, but it also demonstrates to them your support of their ministry in our parishes and communities.

You might not be aware that this is the only collection for our archdiocesan priests' health and retirement, which totals nearly \$13 million annually in health care, nursing, and retirement costs. As well, this collection is separate and distinct from the annual collection for religious order priests, sisters, and brothers.

As I ask you to join me in praying that God continue to bless our dedicated priests, I assure you of my remembrance of you and your families in my prayers and at the Lord's Table.
