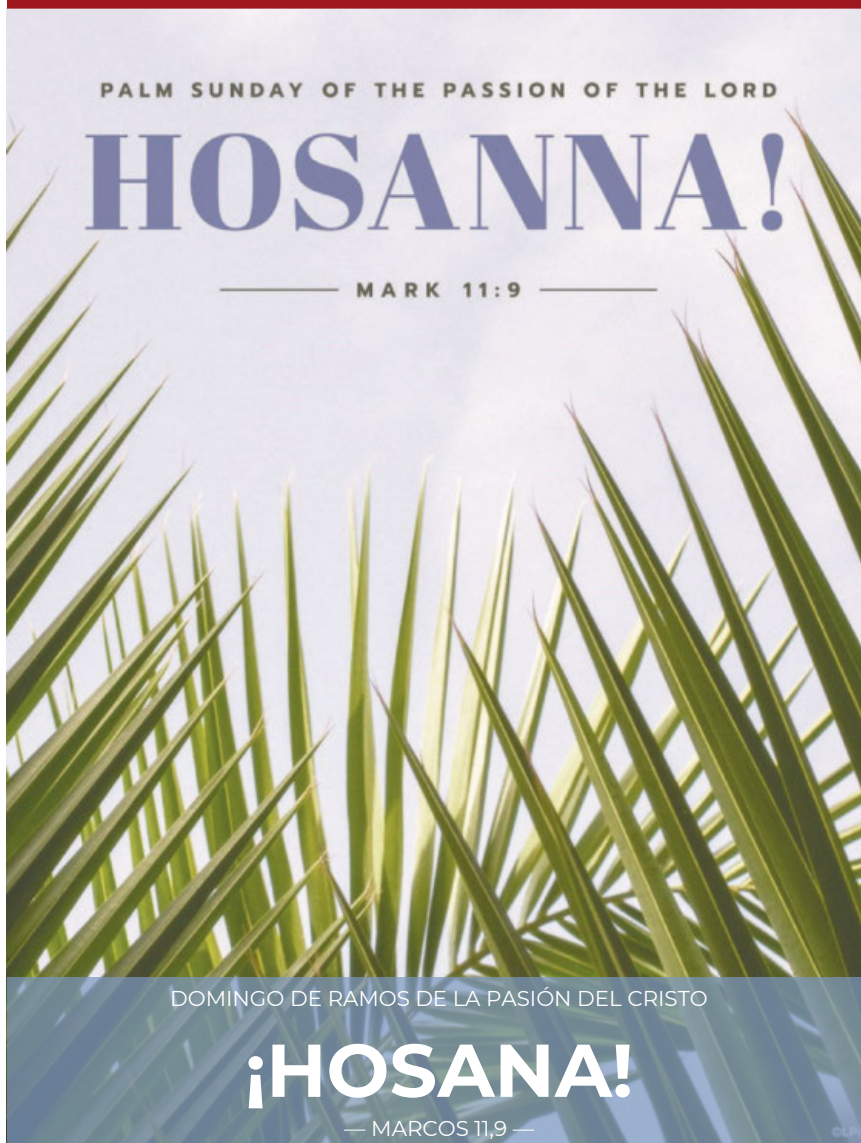

We look on as Jesus suffers His passion and crucifixion. Ultimately, we will experience His glorification from the cross and the tomb.

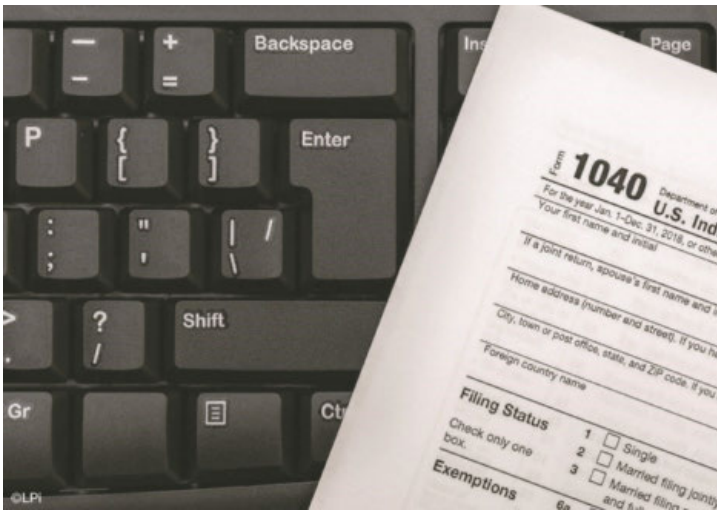
